An Intentional Friend Tool

God gave us the ministry of reconciliation... therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. -2 Corinthians 5:16-20

One thing you can do to be an Intentional Friend to your network of relationships is to ask God to lead you to those who may be most receptive to hearing your story. The My Circle tool will help you begin the process. It's as simple as 1...2...3...

WRITE YOUR NAME IN THE MIDDLE OF THE CIRCLE.

The thing that these people have in common is their connection to you.

ONE:

Write ONE NAME in each circle. Think through where you live, work, learn, and play. Allow God to bring a name to your mind of someone who He may be calling you to get to know better and who may be receptive to hearing your story. If you can't think of any names, your first step is to put yourself out there and get to know some people in these various arenas of your life.

TWO:

Write down TWO PRAYERS for each person. Ask God for opportunities to engage with that person and to stir up their spiritual curiosity.

THREE:

Write THREE DISCOVERIES about each person. Add descriptors. This might happen gradually as you get to know them but begin to create a profile. List keywords that describe that person. Think about how much you know or don't know the people. Don't beat yourself up if you can't name many things. You can begin to consider exploratory questions to learn more about their story.

PUT A STAR NEXT TO THE ONE PERSON THAT GOD WANTS YOU TO BLESS.
